REFLECTIONS ON THE GOSPEL

The word of God which will accompany us for the coming Sundays tell us that Jesus has not come just once, he keeps coming. He comes and is present at all cheerful or sad events of our life; he comes and is present in all that happens in the world and in the Church; especially in those who spread new ideas, utter words of love, peace and reconciliation, in those who strive to build a new world. The readings throughout Advent invite us to be vigilant, to keep our eyes wide open in order to discover and prepare the ways that Jesus has chosen to come and free us from the evil with which we seek happiness, but which, instead, provokes a lot of sorrow. This Advent the Lord God invites us to be ready because He is sending for us the Saviour from the family of David. He will establish peace and justice in the world. The gospel prepares our hearts to wait with trust for the fulfilment of the new world. He demands a radical change in our hearts. Despite difficulties in our world we are required to be vigilant for the coming of the Son of God who comes to bring peace and joy. The last part of the gospel invites us to stay awake and pray. Some people might take this warning lightly, which puts them off from the many commitments of the daily life of reconstructing a better world to live in. Let our activities bring us closer to God and the people God has made us to stay with. By telling us to stay awake Jesus is inviting us to keep our eyes well open so that we may immediately see the needs and hear the requests for help from our brothers and sisters. However, we are not able to listen to the cries of our brothers and sisters if we do not pray ourselves. Prayers keep us vigilant and makes us able to see the suffering in the world which needs help. Lord, your word puts me in a mood of expectation and alertness for your coming. Your coming as a baby at Bethlehem means a lot because our world is surrounded with evil which needs your power to overcome it. May I recognise you in all the moments of my life, to change the things which are obstacles for your coming in my life.
