REFLECTIONS ON THE GOSPEL

On the day of Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles. One remarkable effect of that experience was that the disciples spoke in tongues (their message was meaningful across linguistic divides). This experience has been interpreted in so many different ways. But an understanding of Jesus' own 'Pentecost' experience will give us an insight into what Pentecost experience implies. In Luke 4:18-19 Jesus announces that the spirit of the Lord is upon him (his own Pentecost experience) and he goes on immediately to state the implication of this experience; he says - it has empowered me to bring good news to the poor, to proclaim liberty to captives, to give new sight to the blind, to declare freedom to the oppressed and announce the coming of God's favour! In other words, the spirit empowered him to carry out his mission of love across racial and linguistic boundaries. The Gospels are full of graphic illustrations of how Jesus, empowered by the Spirit, successfully delivered on these missions; restoring the sick to health, the blind to sight, the oppressed to freedom, the hungry to fullness. To speak in a language that is meaningful to people is therefore to intervene meaningfully in people's trying life situations.

FIRST READING

When the day of Pentecost arrived, the Apostles were all together in one place. And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house Holy Spirit, Lord of Light, From the clear celestial height where they were sitting. And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. Now there were lightful guest, Dost refreshing peace bestow Thou in toil art dwelling in Jerusalem Jews, devout men from every nation under heaven. And at this sound the multitude came together, midst of woe. Light immortal, light divine, Visit thou these and they were bewildered, because each one was hearing them speak in his own language. And they were amazed and astonished, saying, 'Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us in his own native language? Parthians and Medes and Elamites and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia the steps that go astray. Thou, on us who evermore. Thee and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabians — we hear them telling in our own tongues the mighty works of God.'

SECOND READING Romans 8:8-17

Brothers and Sisters: Those who are in the flesh cannot please God. You, however, are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if in fact the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ

is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you. So then, brothers and sisters, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. For if you live according to the flesh you will die, but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the Spirit of adoption as sons, by whom we cry, 'Abba! Father!' The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs — heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.
