#### REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL

### Epiphany of the Lord

Epiphany celebrates the visit of the far-travelled magi, understood as the manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles. Matthew's account speaks simply of 'wise men from the east'; later tradition fixed their number at three, made them kings and recalled their resonant names - Caspar, Melchor and Balthazar. The child Jesus, born in a manger is manifested to the Magi; recognised by Simeon and Anna, when he is presented in the Temple for who and what he truly is: 'a light to lighten the Gentiles' and 'the glory of God's people Israel'. Lord, it must have made you glad to give Jesus to the world, when you knew the joy he would bring to people. We pray that, in this New Year, people may open their hearts to Jesus and make room for him in their lives. When Jesus was born, a sparkling star shone in the sky. When Jesus was born, people hurried to the stable to see him. When Jesus was born, God gave the world a very special gift, the gift of love. This year, may we all try to give each other the gift of love. When the Wise Men came they brought much more than gold, frankincense and myrrh. # **TODAY'S READINGS**

#### **ENTRANCE ANTIPHON**

Behold, the Lord, the Mighty One, has come; and kingship is in his grasp, and power and dominion.

#### OPENING PRAYER

O God, who on this day revealed your Only Begotten Son to the nations by the guidance of a star, grant in your mercy that we, who know you already by faith, may be brought to behold the beauty of your sublime glory. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. **Amen.** 

#### FIRST READING Isaiah 60:1-6

Arise, shine out Jerusalem, for your light has come, the glory of the Lord is rising on you, though night still covers the earth and darkness the peoples. Above you the Lord now rises and above you his glory appears. The nations come to your light and kings to your dawning brightness. Lift up your eyes and look round: all are assembling and coming towards you, your sons from far away and daughters being tenderly carried. At this sight you will grow radiant, your heart throbbing and full; since the riches of the sea will flow to you, the wealth of the nations come to you; camels in throngs will cover you, and dromedaries of Midian and Ephah; everyone in Sheba will come, bringing gold and incense and singings the praise of the Lord.

### SECOND READING Ephesians 3:2-3, 5-6

You have probably heard how I have been entrusted by God with the grace he meant for you, and that it was by a revelation that I was given the knowledge of the mystery. This mystery that has now been revealed through the Spirit to his holy apostles and prophets was unknown to any men in past generations; it means that pagans now share the same inheritance, that they are parts of the same body, and that the same promise has been made to them, in Christ Jesus, through the Gospel.

#### **GOSPEL ACCLAMATION**

Alleluia, alleluia! We saw his star as it rose and have come to do the Lord homage. Alleluia!

#### **GOSPEL Mathew 2:1-12**

After Jesus had been born at Bethlehem in Judea during the reign of King Herod, some wise men came to Jerusalem from the east. 'Where is the infant king of the Jews?' they asked. 'We saw his star as it rose and have come to do him homage'. When King Herod heard this he was perturbed, and so was the whole of Jerusalem. He called together all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, and enquired of them where the Christ was to be born. 'At Bethlehem in Judea,' they told him 'for this is what the prophet wrote:

And you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, you are by no mean least among the leaders of Judah, for out of you will come a leader who will shepherd my people Israel.'

Then Herod summoned the wise men to see him privately. He asked them the exact date on which the star had appeared, and sent them on to Bethlehem. 'Go and find out all about the child,' he said 'and when you have found him, let me know, so that I too may go and do him homage.' Having listened to what the king had to say, they set out. And there in front of them was the star they had seen rising; it went forward and halted over the place where the child was. The sight of the star filled them with delight, and going into the house they saw the child with his mother Mary, and falling to their knees they did him homage. Then, opening their treasures, they offered him gifts of gold and frankincense and myrrh. But they were warned in a dream not to go back to Herod, and returned to their own country by a different way.

#### PRAYER OVER THE GIFTS

Look with favour, Lord, we pray, on these gifts of your Church, in which are offered now not gold or frankincense or myrrh, but he who by them is proclaimed, sacrificed and received, Jesus Christ. Who lives and reigns for ever and ever. **Amen.**
