REFLECTION ON THE GOSPEL

HOLY TRINITY: BUY ONE GET TWO FREE!

The doctrine of the Trinity holds that the one God exists in three persons; the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit with each being fully and equally God, yet there are not three Gods but one. The One God existing in three persons is an indication that God does not exist in isolation but in a community of love and sharing. And the reason why knowing this nature of God is important to us is that since we are made in the image of God, the more we conform to this nature in our own lives, the more we live true to our nature therefore becoming the best we can be as human beings. We, who are made in the image (nature) of a Trinitarian God that exists in a community of love and sharing, are therefore called to a life of relationships, a life of sharing. It is not consistent with our nature to live in isolation. The Gospel therefore challenges our culture of individualism and independence which can degenerate to selfishness. Soon, we begin to pay the price when we insist on living contrary to our nature in the Trinitarian God; we become lonely, depressed and dehumanised in isolation. To underscore the importance of relationships and inter-dependence, God even went to the extent of stepping out of that Trinitarian comfort to take our human nature in Jesus. We are therefore challenged to step farther out of our comfort zones and reach out as missionaries to the wider humanity especially to those out there in the cold.
